WHAT WE ARE ALL ABOUT

In 2003, Community Action, Inc. (now Youth Action Hudson, Inc.) asked if the Hudson, Somerset, and North Hudson Police Departments



would combine efforts and join them in developing a coalition to combat underage drinking in their communities. All three departments readily joined thus creating the partnership which is now called the St. Croix Underage Drinking Coalition.

Together we can combat youth access to alcohol

The coalition then applied for grant monies to assist each department in the mission to prevent youth access to alcohol.

The WI Department of Transportation funded each department for their full request for support.

The coalition is now the largest coalition of its kind in the State of Wisconsin and one of the largest in the United States. We have the support and partnership of all law enforcement agencies in St. Croix County. We have created a program that is mimic around the state. We hope to sustain our growth with the help from state funding and support from you...the community

Compliance Checks

A compliance check is a tool to identify alcohol establishments that sell alcohol to underage youth. Compliance checks are used for two purposes:

- 1: To enforce state criminal statues, local ordinances, or both.
- 2: To identify, warn, and educate alcohol establishments that serve or sell alcohol to underage youth.

The Coalition had developed a comprehensive compliance check program that identifies infractions of state law as well as training opportunities.

Enforcement Activities

The Coalition has identified other enforcement activities to combat youth access to alcohol. "Cops in shops" utilizes undercover officers in alcohol establishments to identify underage persons attempting to procure alcohol. "Party patrols" involves police saturations during likely times of underage consumption.

Services

The St. Croix Underage Drinking Coalition provides free training to all interested parties regarding the laws pertaining to retail sales of alcohol.

In addition we will provide voluntary compliance checks to any establishment that wishes to evaluate the effectiveness of staff screening of underage persons.

Provide support for any law enforcement agency when completing enforcement activities regard-

ing underage drinking/ access to alcohol.
